

SCCHEA Homeschool Co-op Spring 2017

The SCCHEA Homeschool Co-op is designed to enrich SCCHEA homeschool children's educational experiences in a positive Christian atmosphere. Parents share their talents and skills in order to provide their children with a wider range of activities and an opportunity to interact in a group setting.

In order to facilitate a rewarding experience for all, we each agree to the following:

Each family will donate its time to the co-op by teaching, assisting, or in some other assigned duty. Any students wishing to teach a class must be at least 16 years old and will submit a complete lesson schedule for approval by the director and co-director, and will have an adult assistant.

Co-op will be open to SCCHEA members only. Co-op participation is a benefit of membership.

A parent or legal guardian must be on the premises at all times during co-op. In cases of emergency, arrangements may be made with another adult to be responsible for the child/children. The co-op director is to be advised before co-op begins on the day in question, or before the parent/guardian leaves premises.

Parents should not bring children with obvious signs of illness to co-op. Students may return when symptoms have subsided for at least 24 hours.

As a matter of respect for the time and effort that teachers and staff have put into preparation, members make every effort to be on time for co-op. Announcements are only given during the opening assembly.

Midtown Church has generously donated their facility as a meeting place for our co-op. In addition to treating the building and grounds with the respect you would ordinarily show a place of worship, to show our appreciation, we agree to the following:

Each family will donate \$5.00 to be given to the church to help defray costs.

Leave each room as we found it (or better).

Furnish our own supplies (i.e. copies, snacks, nursery supplies, art & craft supplies, etc.).

Each family will donate \$2.00 to be given to the co-op director to help defray costs.

We, as parents, are ultimately responsible for our children, both spiritually and physically. If our child damages property or hurts another individual, we as parents, assume all responsibility, financial and/or otherwise.

All participants will be expected to show respect to other people and their property. Foul language and disrespectful or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Dress should be modest. We encourage any disputes to be resolved using the process outlined in Matthew 18:15-16, 21-22.
